In order to be eligible for NHS, students must have an un-rounded cumulative grade point average of 3.80 (Due to the change in grading scale, for the class of 2018 it is 3.6, and for the class of 2017 it is 3.4).

The only exception to this is hours accumulated over the summer vacation which must be turned in within a week after school has resumed. No more than six hours may be turned in for the same activity. Community service may not be during the school day.
